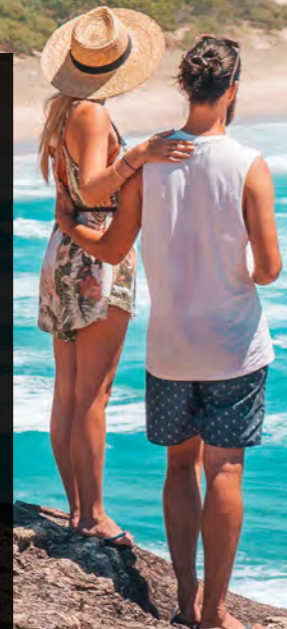

EVACUATION PROCEDURE

Prior to an evacuation, the following ground announcement will be made over the PA System:

"Ladies and Gentlemen, Management has requested that although you are in no immediate danger, for your safety we have to stop the game(s) temporarily and evacuate the fields. Please remain calm and move towards the evacuation point."

The appropriate evacuation process is:

1. After ground announcement (above), all staff/ volunteers are to provide guidance and assistance to patrons if an evacuation is conducted.
2. Patrons are to be evacuated to a safe area— clear of problematic, damaged facilities or objects that could cause further harm.
3. A count of all patrons present should be conducted as soon as all are seated and reasonably calm.
4. Patrons and staff are to remain seated in the designated area, until Emergency Services have given the 'all clear.'

PLEASE NOTE: There are multiple evacuation points located around the venue. Please head to the closest point in case of emergency. See event precinct map on [page 20](#).

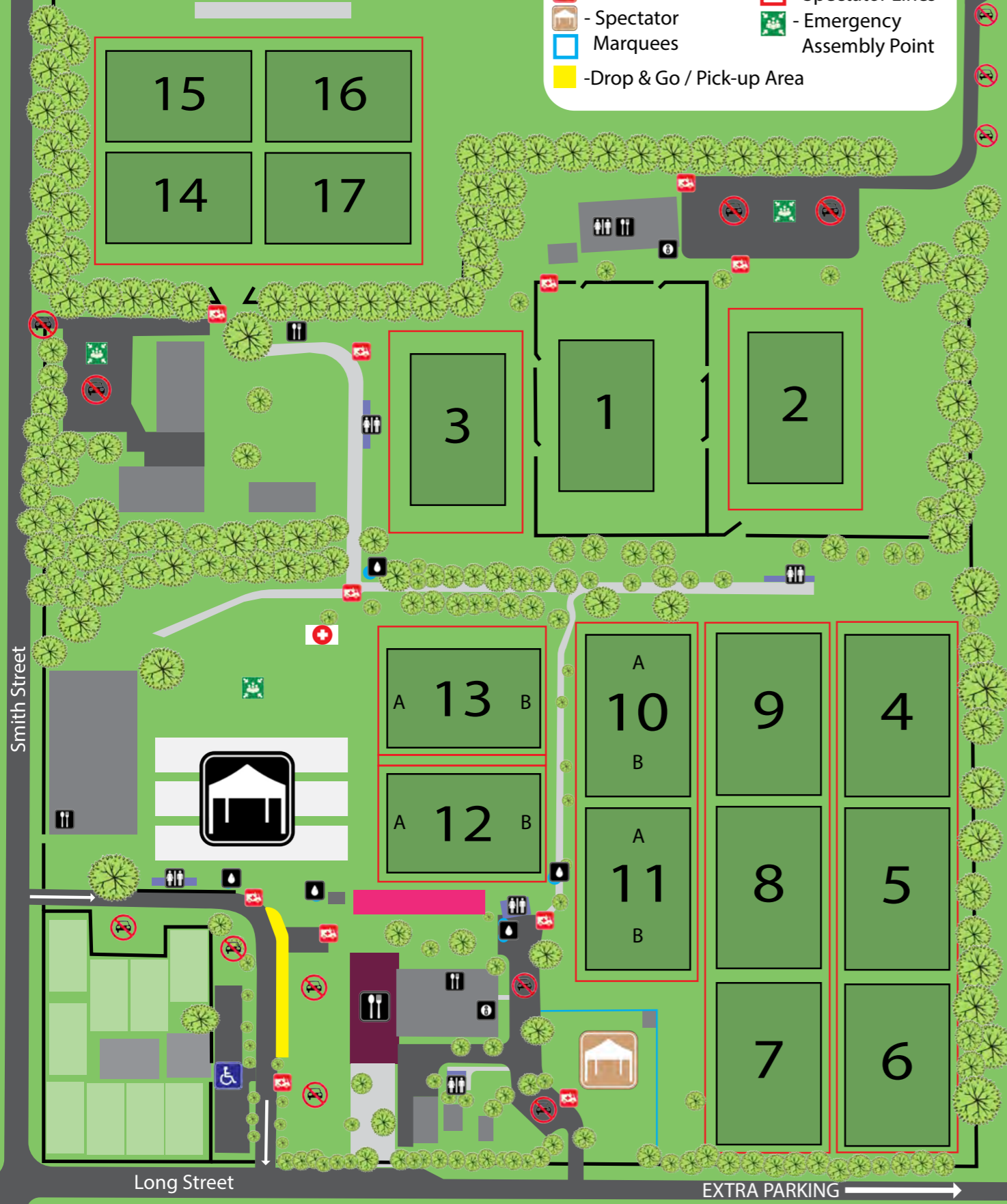

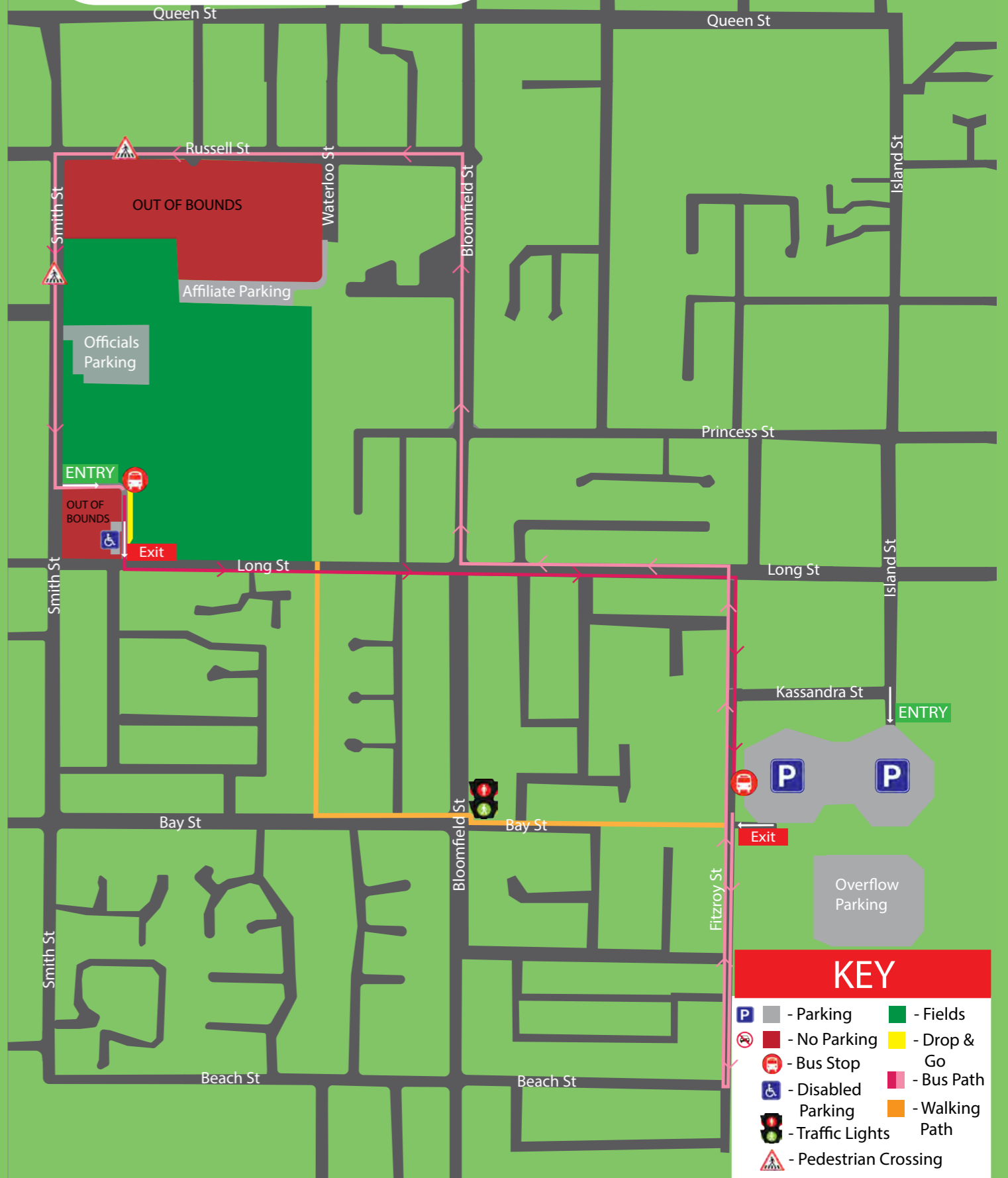

COMMUNICATION BETWEEN REFEREE & COACH

To prevent heated confrontations and/or the escalation of incidents occurring in the game, the captain, coach and/or team managers are encouraged to have respectful and ongoing communication prior to, during and at the completion of the game. This includes the answering of general questions only, however, does not permit the captain, coach and/or team manager to abuse and/or repeatedly question the match official(s).

If any communication between a coach and/or team manager and match official(s) becomes aggressive and/or confrontational, communication between all parties is to cease immediately.

Referees are instructed to no longer engage with the player, coach, manager or official and will walk away from any possible confrontation reporting it to the QTF Referee Manager.

NOTE:

No person is permitted to approach a match official (referee) after the game has concluded and the score sheet signed. Similarly, no heated exchanges are to occur with referee, coaches or other event official in the vicinity.

Breaches of the QTF Code of Behaviour will be referred to QTF Judiciary Panel. Referrals may lead to suspension and possible exclusion from the event, or fines for both the individual and affiliate.

TEAM SPRINT RELAY

KEY INFORMATION

The ever-popular Team Sprint Relay, supported by My Health For Life, will return in 2024!

Date: Friday 5 July

Time: 12:50pm -1:20pm

Marshalling Location: Teams are to marshal on field 2 at 12:40pm, view map on page 20.

TEAM NOMINATIONS

Teams must nominate their sprint relay teams prior to 5pm Thursday 4 July at the Information Desk. Team registration sheets will be available from Thursday morning for team managers to nominate teams.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Teams must consist of four athletes from the same team (same affiliate, age division and gender).
- Affiliates may enter more than one relay team per age division, however the number of relay teams must not exceed the number of touch teams competing in the carnival, per age division. i.e. if an affiliate has two touch teams competing in the carnival in one age division, they may enter one or two relay teams.
- Teams **MUST** nominate prior to nomination deadline. No entries will be accepted on the day.
- Teams must be in attendance and ready for marshalling by 12:40pm.
- **NO DIVING** will be allowed in the relay for safety reasons, any athlete who dives across the finish line will result in their team being disqualified.
- Teams must bring their own ball to use during the relay.

TEAM RELAY FORMAT

Under 10 Divisions:

- Race will be run over half the field length
- First runner will start with the ball in hand
- Runners pass the ball within the 5m area to the next runner
- All runners will **RUN** across the try line
- The winner will be the first team across the try line, any player who dives will be disqualified.

Under 12, 14, 16 & 18 Divisions:

- Race will run over the full field
- First runner scoops the ball on the 5m mark
- Runners pass the ball within the 5m area to the next runner
- All runners will **RUN** across the try line
- The winner will be the first team across the try line, any player who dives will be disqualified.
- One race will be run per age division, Girls and Boys races may be run at the same time if numbers are low, however there will be a Girls and Boys winner.

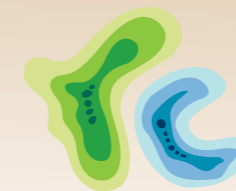
